Economic Impact of Research²

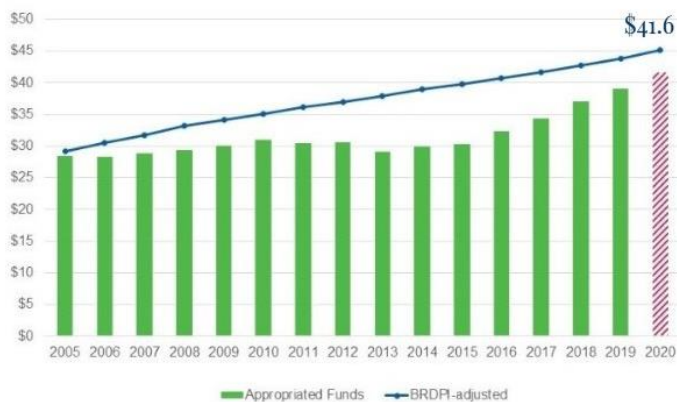
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2018, NIH funded awards totaling **\$607.7 million** in Florida, supporting **14,036 jobs** and **\$1.962 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2018, the biopharmaceutical industry in Florida supported **87,061 jobs** and **6,198 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Florida³

- In 2019, an estimated 1,762,450 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **131,470** will reside in Florida.
- In 2019, an estimated 606,880 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **45,000** residents of Florida.
