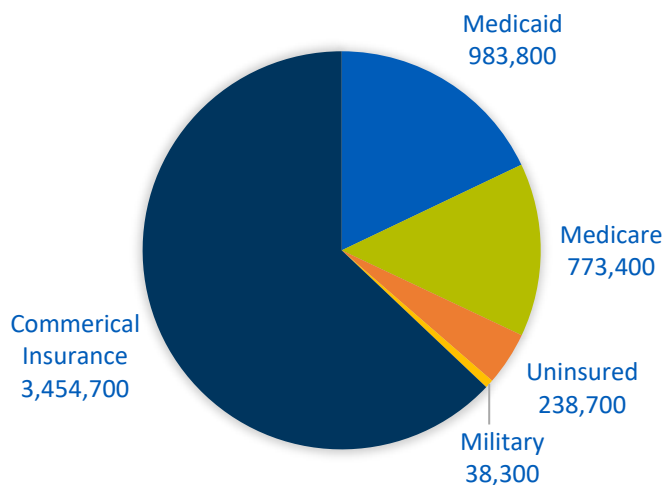


Medicaid Coverage for Clinical Trials in Minnesota HF3026/SF3125

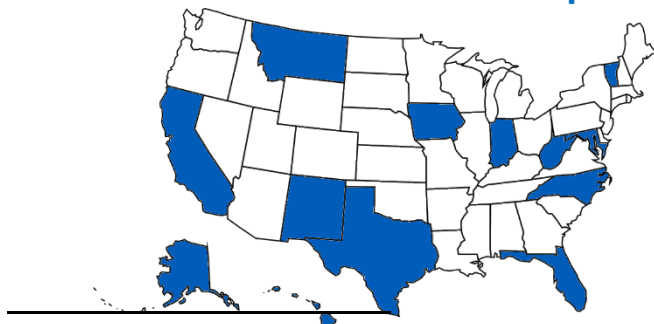
983,800 Minnesotans are covered by state-funded Medicaid¹. Current statute does not require Medicaid coverage of routine care costs associated with a patient's illness if a patient enrolls in a clinical trial.



This leaves nearly 1 million Minnesotans with Medical Assistance plans without guaranteed access to a clinical trial and the possibility to cure their disease.



13 states and the District of Columbia require coverage for clinical trial enrollment through their Medicaid programs² with minimal or no fiscal impact.



HF3026/SF3125 will enable Medicaid patients to enroll in one of the approximately 2,000
